SPEAKER: Mr. Dale Lang



Dale Lang was born and raised in the Calgary area. He became a hot air balloon pilot in 1974 after which time he opened and operated his own full-time balloon business. Dale won the first Canadian National Hot Air Balloon Championship in 1979 and then co-piloted the first balloon over the North Pole in 1980.

In 1984 Dale left the balloon business and was hired as a youth worker at St. James Anglican Church in Calgary. During this time, he developed a 'Divine dissatisfaction' and desired to do more for the Lord. He was ordained in the Anglican Church and attended Trinity Episcopal School for Ministry (Ambridge, Pennsylvania) to attain his Master of Divinity Degree. The Langs returned home to Alberta and were hired by St. Theodore's Church in Taber where they ministered for 15 years.

Dale married his high school sweetheart, Diane, and they had five children. In 1999, Dale's second oldest son, Jason, was shot and killed at the age of 17 while attending high school. Dale's story of forgiveness in a time of loss is one that has been heard across Canada at high schools, conferences, conventions, the National Prayer Breakfast, churches and numerous other functions.

Dale currently ministers around the county and at home in Taber, AB with the Solid Rock Youth and Family Foundation.
